Homelessness is more pronounced in the NT than elsewhere in Australia.

People who have experienced homelessness in their life might have been..

- Staying somewhere temporarily, like living with family or friends or couchsurfing
- Living in supported accommodation for the homeless, women's shelters, refuges or boarding houses
- Living in severely overcrowded houses or other dwellings
- Rough sleepers or live in improvised dwellings, tents or cars

The current homelessness system can be strengthened to better meet the needs of people experiencing homelessness. Homelessness is experienced differently throughout the Northern Territory, but support is required everywhere.

What will the LEAG do?

- Meet online 4-6 times per year from September 2026 at a rate of \$100 per hour
- Meet in person 1-2 times per year
- Work together to shape lived experience into strategic recommendations for NT Government, influencing policy, systems and programs

Who are we looking for?

- Members from all 6 NT regions: Greater Darwin, Central Australia, Barkly, Big Rivers, East Arnhem, Top End
- People from diverse backgrounds including Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders, people who have experienced domestic, family or sexual violence, people with experiences of out of home care or foster care, LGBTQIASB+, people with a disability, culturally and linguistically diverse
- People who can use their personal experience to make recommendations for system and policy changes
- People who respect differences and are committed to inclusion
- A group with a mix of perspectives, experiences and strengths

How to apply

1. Submit an expression of interest online or over the phone
2. A LEAG worker will call you to have a yarn over the phone, asking some more questions and learning more about you
3. All applicants will be contacted with an outcome
